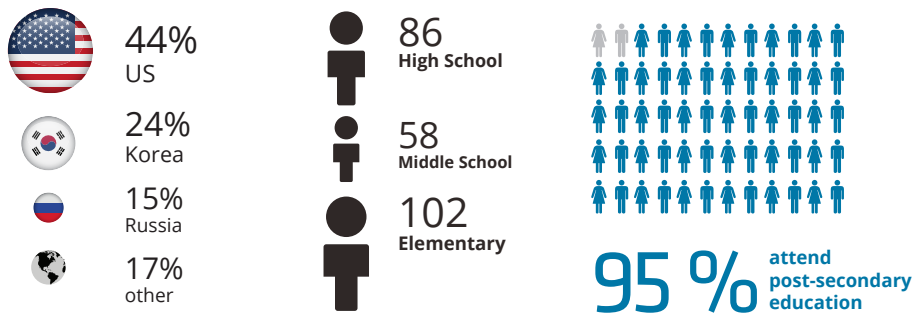

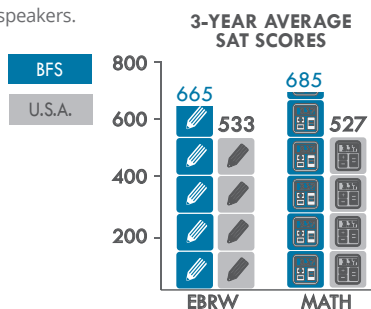


SAT

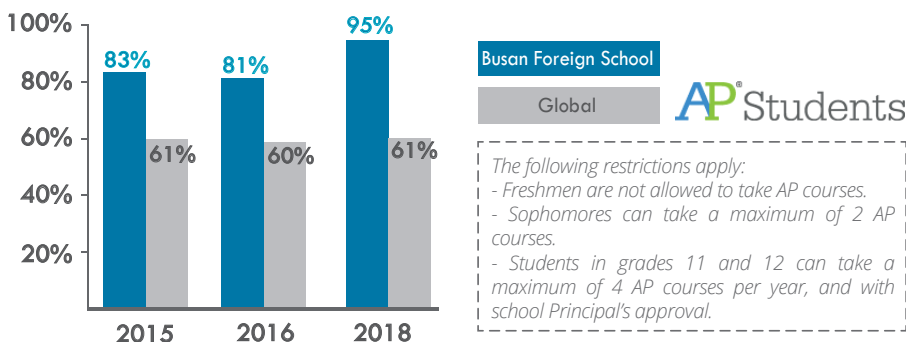
2017 and 2018: average of Fall and Spring scores

FACULTY

For 2018-19, BFS has thirty-three full time teachers. Thirteen teachers have master's degrees. One holds a Ph.D. and one holds an Ed.D. All teachers are certified in their grade level and content area in either the United States or Canada. Twenty three teachers are from the U.S.A., five are from Canada, four are from Korea, and one is from Spain.

The average class size is 14.

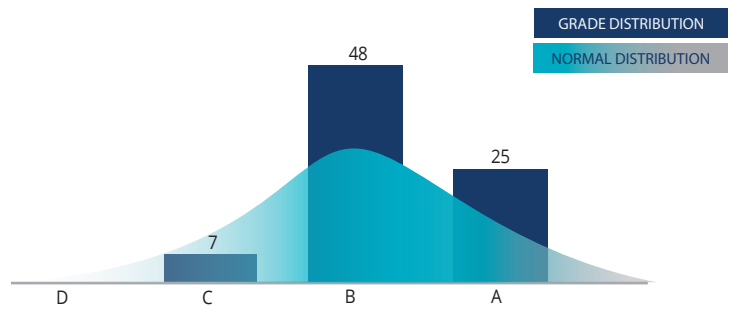
MISSION STATEMENT

CURRICULUM

BFS offers a challenging U.S. standards-based curriculum with additional international content aimed at preparing students for post-secondary studies in the U.S. and abroad. Our high school includes several Advanced Placement courses. BFS is a proud member of the AP Capstone Program. Almost 95% of BFS graduates go on to post-secondary studies, the majority of which attend high-ranking universities in the United States. An ELL program, which includes both inclusion and small group models, is available for students who qualify in grades K5-12.
