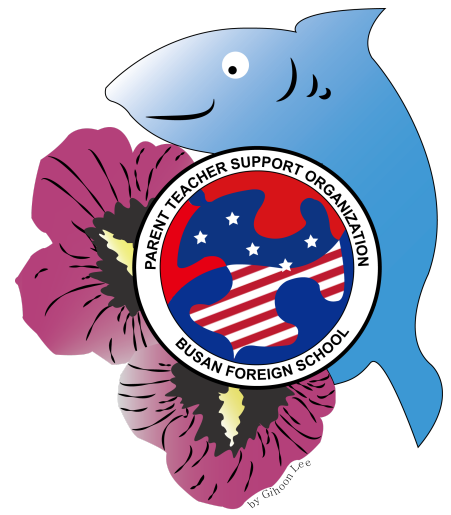

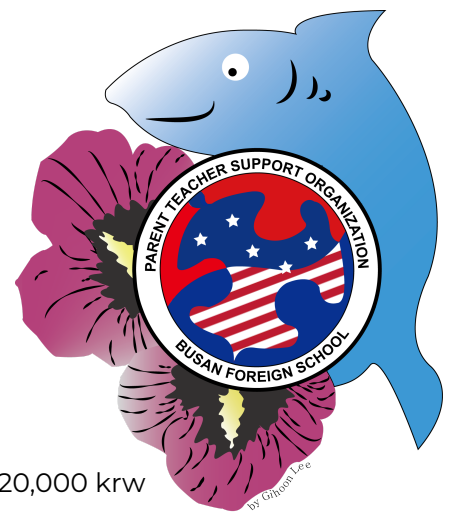

## OPEN FLOOR

Close contact question: the Korean government is not strictly monitoring close contacts anymore. Hence, we really rely on our families to proactively reach out to us. BFS recommends in case of doubt, to take a RAT (home or clinic).

The general guideline is that a close contact is anyone having been in the same space for an extensive amount of time (15 min or more) wearing masks, or in the

same space for a short amount of time without masks during 2 days prior to the contact taking the test.
