New Business

- PTSO, what does it mean? What is the purpose?
 - PTSO stands for Parent Teacher Support Organization. We are the non academic support team for the school, think of it as another layer of safety net for supporting both the students and the teacher. The organization exists to support the school.
- How can you support?
 - Time (Volunteering)

 - Parent representatives are volunteers who answered the volunteer call during the first meeting. Due to our PTSO not having officers and board members, the parent representatives have acted as the board representative of the PTSO with voting rights.
- Funds. Why do we fundraise?
 - Towards a cause at the end of the year (?)
 - Have budget for teacher/staff appreciations at least once a quarter and at least one breakfast/lunch/dinner paid by PTSO
 - Have budget for volunteer appreciation or luncheon at least once during the school year
 - Have a budget to support school related events
 - Maintain a 3,000,000 KRW balance for events/appreciation and for student/teacher grants for the following school year
 - Abigail suggestion:
 - If we fundraise enough or have more than 3,000,000 at the end of the school year, we can donate at least:
